



KILIMA CAMP – How it started

In December 2006, 5 friends on safari in the Maasai Mara decided that it would be great to set up a camp and offer tourists an experience close to what they were having while camping.

As 2 of them (Axel & Dominique) have been living in Kenya for 15 years, they were in charge of setting up this project.

Only one year later, Pascal, designer in London, Veronique and Yvon, ex-

bankers, were coming back to Kenya for New Years' Eve at Kilima Camp, a dream come true.

After getting all the relevant authorizations, they received their first clients in July 2007. After one-year operation, they are proud to get already repeat clients who love the eco concept of the camp which combines simplicity and style.

Kilima Camp and the environment

Kilima Camp is an eco-friendly camp with emphasis on the respect of the environment and the people. Some 2700 indigenous trees have been planted, the water comes from a rainwater catchment and showers are offered in buckets to avoid wastage. The lights are generated by solar power.

Only dead branches are used to lit the camp fire in the evening.
